04404 How to Memorize Gender of Nouns: A Reference Material

1. Hindi nouns are either masculine or feminine.

2. Nouns that end in the sound an are almost always masculine.

3. Nouns that end in the sound $\frac{1}{5}$ are almost always feminine.

4. One can safely assume that words borrowed from English will behave like feminine nouns.

4. Consciously memorize all feminine nouns that do not end in $\frac{1}{5}$ and are not English loan words.

5. Consciously memorize all exceptions to rules 2 and 3 (i.e. all masculine nouns ending in ई (like दही 'yogurt' and 'पानी'water) and all feminine nouns ending in आ (like भाषा 'language' and माता 'mother').

5. Assume that all other nouns are masculine.

Following these simple rules will significantly reduce the amount of memorization you need to do.
