

17601 What Should I Do? Game

This game is designed to introduce students to the first person subjunctive and to increase spoken language. First it's necessary to find a subject that the class can be concerned about. Possibilities include:

Parents of a teen-ager hanging with a bad crowd or whatever. Should you talk to a Dr.?, ask kid/others about drugs?, discuss with other kids' parents? (डाक्टर से बात करूं, बेटे से ड्रग के बारे में पूछूं; दूसरे बच्चों के माता-पिताजी से बात करूं)

Parents of young children or new baby. He's crying, what should I do. Should I change diaper, feed him, nurse him, put him down to sleep, burp etc. (नैपी बदलना, खिलाना, पिलाना, सुलाना, बर्प करवाना)

Husband/boyfriend; Wife/girlfriend ...

Create a Drill

1. Teacher states problem:
2. Students repeat the problem:
3. All: मैं क्या करूं?
4. Teacher: Should I? (English, then Hindi)
5. Students repeat the Hindi

Variation:

Start with each individual stating a problem in Hindi (give some time for them to come up with) and continue as above.
