

19300 Translate to Perfect/Simple Past (ने verbs)

NOTE: I have adopted this from Jain's Transformation Drill 7, p182. All of these verbs are transitive (ie ने verbs) and in all cases you are asked to translate into the perfect (ie simple past). Therefore the logical subject (in all cases 'I') will take the post position ने. The verb then will agree with the direct object (DO) unless there is no DO or if the DO is followed by a post position, in which case the ने verb takes the masculine singular form.

1. I cooked Indian food yesterday.
2. Yesterday I ate food with you.
3. Yesterday I bought two shirts (कमीज़)
4. I cleaned my room yesterday.
5. I wrote a letter to my friend yesterday.
6. Yesterday I read these books.
7. Yesterday I washed my clothes.
8. Yesterday I saw this film.
9. I did my work yesterday.
10. I gave you the money yesterday.
