Jain, Chapter 24, pp 177-179, The Perfect Tense of Transitive, or ने Verbs

Definitions:

Transitive Verbs can take a DO [direct object] i.e. can answer the question V what? *Intransitive Verbs* cannot take DO

The following applies to the perfect tenses only (eg perfect, present perfect, past perfect)

- a) the logical subject of transitive verbs takes the post position ने
- b) the transitive verb agrees with the DO in number and gender unless there is no DO or if the DO is followed by a post position in which case the ने verb takes the masculine singular form (default)

Special pronoun forms with ने are:

मैंने I

तुने you (familiar)

इन्होने they (close)

उन्होने they (distant)

किन्होने ? who all?

Transitive verbs that do not take ने are:

ले जाना to bring

ले चलना to take away

ले आना to bring

लाना to bring

भूलना to forget

से डरना to be afraid of

से मिलना to meet someone (when the meeting is planned)

सकना to be able to V (whether used with transitive or intransitive main verb)

लगना to begin to V (whether used with transitive or intransitive main verb)

Verbs where ने is optional

बोलना to speak; समझना to understand; खेलना to play
